Pool Rules 2018

General Rules

- 1. The pavilion and pool is provided for all land and homeowners **only**, no outside groups, to use and enjoy that are in good standing with the HoA.
- 2. The pool is open to all owners always, even if an owner is utilizing the pavilion for a private party.
- 3. Smoking is prohibited within the clubhouse and the pool area.
- 4. No glass containers are allowed within the pool area.
- 5. Children must be accompanied by an adult always within the pool gates. It recommended that all children have a life vest or other floatation device for safety.
- 6. Bands, DJ's etc., as well as users of the facility and pool must be respectful of neighbors and maintain a volume that doesn't disturb others.
- 7. No running or horse play is allowed in the pool area.
- 8. All guest should be accompanied by a resident.
- 9. Residents are allowed a maximum of 6 guest during a visit to the pool.
- 10.All toys, floats, towels, chairs, etc., should be removed when resident/guest leaves the pool or pavilion area for the day.
- 11.Keep pool gate closed and locked at all times.
- 12.Pool users are required to have a cell phone with them at all time in case of emergency.
- 13.No lifeguard is on duty, swim at your own risk. Due to depth of the pool, no diving at any time.
- 14.Pool hours are 10AM to 10PM
